





V<sub>DS</sub> - Drain-to-Source Voltage (V)

### **Output Characteristics**




On-Resistance vs. Drain Current and Gate Voltage






V<sub>GS</sub> - Gate-to-Source Voltage (V)

On-Resistance vs. Junction Temperature









### Source-Drain Diode Forward Voltage

\* V<sub>GS</sub> > minimum V<sub>GS</sub> at which R<sub>DS(on)</sub> is specified


Safe Operating Area, Junction-to-Ambient



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
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
